

Child Protection

Activity Centre users have a responsibility for the supervision of their own youth members' programmes within the rules of their own organisations.

Walton Firs Foundation believes however, that it has an over-riding responsibility to ensure the safety and well being of **all** Activity Centre users.

In order to meet these responsibilities Walton Firs Foundation requires all persons in charge of groups using the Activity Centre and its facilities to carry out and abide by the following conditions:

- ❑ **All** adults (i.e. over the age of 18), within your party must have under gone full enquiry procedures and checks by your organisation and have a CRB disclosure confirming they are suitable to work alongside young people.
- ❑ **All** adults within your party must be informed that contravention of the *Child Protection Code of Practice* could lead to them being asked to leave the site.

All persons in charge of groups, prior to the commencement of their stay, must sign the following declaration:
