Step 1 – Identify fire hazards		
Sources of ignition: Naked Flames.	Sources of Fuel: Timber, Plastics, Chemicals, Fabrics, Camping/Activity equipment.	Sources of Oxygen: Atmosphere

Step 2 – People at Risk
Site Staff, Visitors and Campers.

Step 3 – Evaluate, Remove, Reduce and protect from risk	
(3.1) Evaluate the risk of the fire occurring.	Low Risk for all unless, campers or Visitors bring sources of ignition. I.e. fires campfires, BBQ's or Cooking equipment under the shelter.
(3.2) Evaluate the Risk to people from a fire starting on the premises.	Low risk to site staff campers and visitors as it has open sides al the way around. It is a small single storey Shelter structure.
(3.3) Remove and reduce the hazards that may cause a fire.	Policies in place to keep naked flames out of the shelter no exceptions. It is clear no smoking and cooking in or near the shelter.
(3.4) Remove and Reduce the risks to people from a fire.	Following site rules, policies and procedures.
