(3.3) Remove and reduce the hazards that may cause a fire.	Policies in place to keep naked flames out of the shelter no exceptions. No smoking and cooking in or near the shelter.	
(3.4) Remove and Reduce the risks to people from a fire.	Following site rules, policies and procedures.
